We have created a RENOVATION COMMITTEE to determine the necessary and desired items to make our Eagle Aerie #204 more efficient, comfortable and stylish. Our goal is to create a place for all of us, along with our families and friends, to spend time in with a sense of pride, having been able to participate in the upcoming projects!

The committee has deemed **STAGE 1** priorities as:

- replacing the very old and failing **BAR COOLERS** with modern and efficient new coolers, helped by rebates from our Chelan PUD.
- replacing the torn, worn and crumbling **BOOTHS** with a modern seating design to help create more space for all our members to be comfortable in the dining room.

Recently, reimbursement requests have been submitted for:

- cleaning supplies already in inventory.
- duplicate food items.
- trophies for unverified events.
- unnecessary or premature purchases.
- overpriced items due to inefficient purchasing.

Effective Immediately:

All payments must be either:

1. made by an authorized Purchasing Agent, or
2. pre-approved in writing by the relevant Purchasing Agent.

Purchases made outside of this process will not be reimbursed and will be considered a donation.

Reminder:

If something needs to be paid for or purchased:

1. Contact the relevant Purchasing Agent.
2. They will seek Aerie approval at the next regular business meeting.
3. Only after approval, will the purchase be made.
