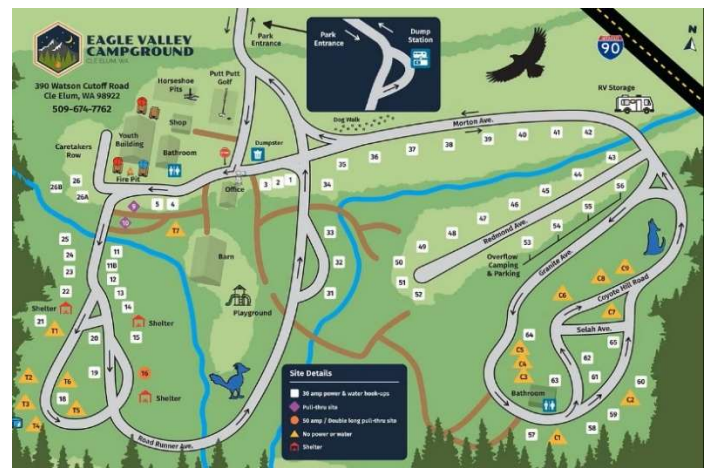


GET READY TO CAMP!

A CLOSER LOOK: HOW THE CLUB IS GOVERNED

A Description of the Duties of Each Office



In the local Fraternal Order of Eagles (F.O.E.), the Aerie and Auxiliary are governed by elected officers. Their primary duties center on maintaining the organization's four pillars: **Liberty, Truth, Justice, and Equality.**

Aerie and Auxiliary Presidents

Worthy President (Aerie) and Madam President (Auxiliary): It is the duty of the President to enforce all of the Laws of our Order, and to make sure all reports required to be filed by all officers are transmitted to the appropriate Grand Aerie Department so that the Aerie is in compliance with the Laws of the Order.

The President has general supervision over all affairs of the Aerie and appoint most committees. They should see that harmony is maintained and that all of the



officers cooperate with one another as well as ensure that officers perform their duties in the right manner at all times. In the event that an officer fails to appear for the regular meeting, it is the required duty of the President to fill the vacancy for that particular meeting from the members present.

Aerie and Auxiliary Vice Presidents

Worthy / Madam Vice President: Assists the President in maintaining order and assumes their powers if the President is absent or unable to serve.

The Worthy Vice President shall assist the Worthy President in preserving order and decorum in the meetings, shall inspect all ballots on applicants in conjunction with the President, and perform all other duties required of him by the Laws of Order. If a vacancy occurs in the office of Worthy President, the Worthy Vice President must succeed to that office, leaving the office of Vice President empty.

Junior Past President: A position automatically filled by the retiring President. They serve as an advisor and counselor to the current President.

Administrative & Financial Officers

Secretary: This is one of the most important offices of the Local Aerie. The Secretary comes in contact with the entire membership more than any other officer, as he/she is collecting dues from the members and corresponding with them relative to various activities and programs. The Secretary manages the roster and records in a Membership Management System, oversees Funds (Social Fund, Building-Maintenance, etc.,) keeps minutes of proceedings, issues membership cards, and handles official correspondence. The Secretary is the primary business executor who acts as Financial Manager, files taxes, prepares annual reports and much more.

Treasurer: Responsible for the custody of all funds. They receive money from the Secretary, deposit it into designated bank accounts, and sign warrant checks for approved expenditures. The Treasurer submits an annual report which furnishes important information to our local office that is required for the annual report to the Grand Aerie.

Auditor: Conducts regular audits of the Aerie's books (at least quarterly) to ensure financial transparency and compliance.

Ritualistic & Operational Officers

Worthy / Madam Chaplain: Leads devotional exercises and prayers according to the Order's Ritual. They often promote the spiritual and moral welfare of the members.

Worthy / Madam Conductor: Manages the logistics of the meeting room. They examine membership receipts, prepare the ballot box for new candidates, and introduce visitors.

Inside Guards: Control access to the meeting room by examining receipts at the inner door to ensure only members in good standing enter.

Board of Trustees: The custodians of the property. They manage the club's physical assets, oversee employees, and enforce "House Rules" for the social room. The Trustees endeavor to operate the Local Aerie in a "fiscally sound" as well as "physically sound" manner to help maintain the value and appearance of the Club. Good management and efficient administration work to maintain an orderly, clean, and enjoyable Club.
